What is it?

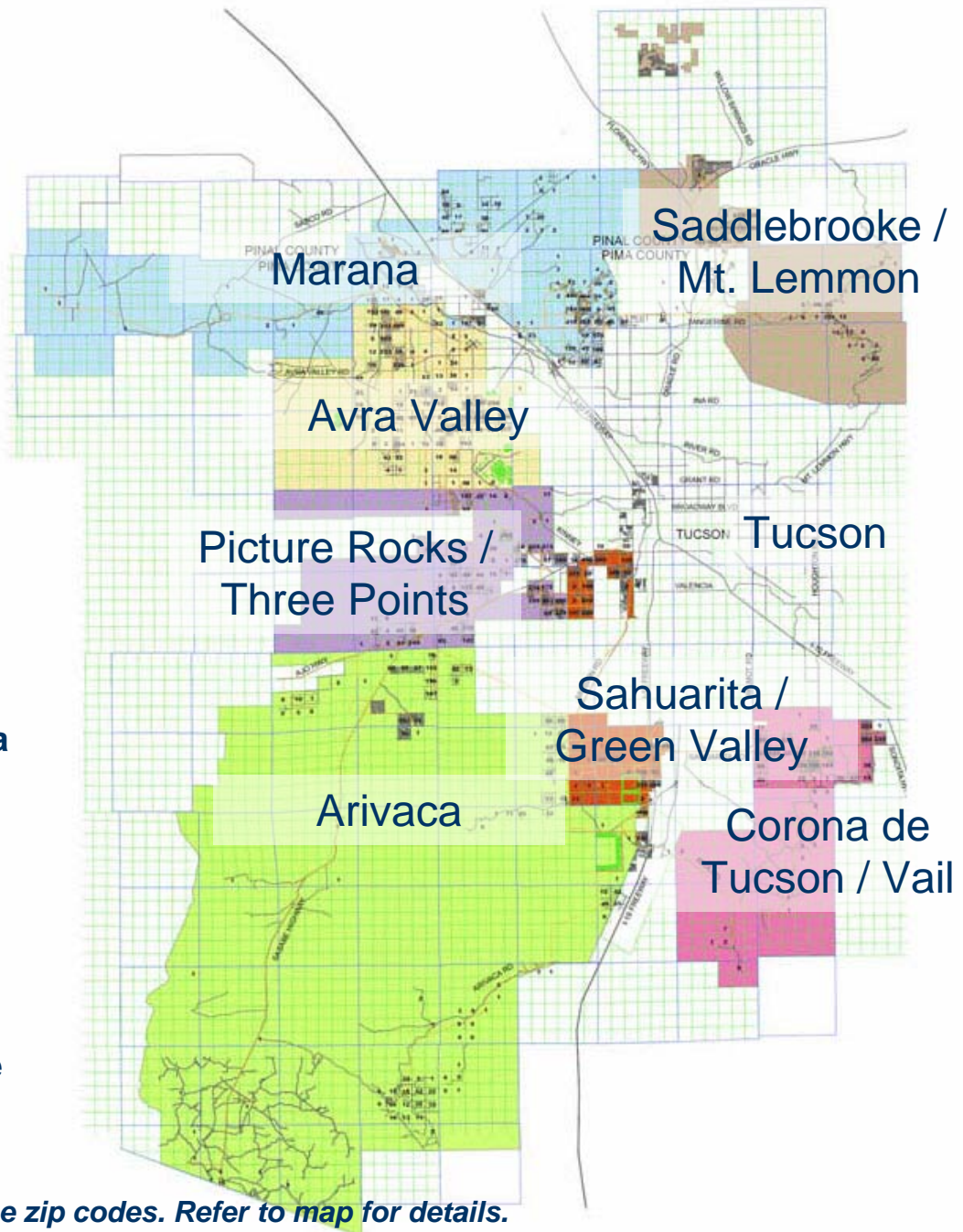
- Trico's community giving program
- This is the POWER Grants 3rd year
- \$40,000 in funding available
- Individual grants up to \$10,000
- 2010 funding focus:
Food and Basic Need—Adults

Guidelines

- Organizations must be non-profit according to IRS code
- Need not be located in Trico's service territory in order to be considered
 - however, you must demonstrate that a significant number of the Adults served by your program live in Trico's service area.

Application Process

- Application available on web site:

- Deadline: December 11, 2009, by 3:00 p.m.
- Selection made by committee in February 2010
- Announcement made in March 2010

Restrictions

- In general, Trico POWER grants are not intended to benefit the following:
 - Religious, fraternal or social organizations
 - Political or partisan organizations or candidates
 - Individuals
 - Other businesses
 - Endowments or foundations
 - Capital improvements such as land purchase, building construction, major building modifications, etc.
 - Travel funds
 - Adult sports
 - Programs or agencies that expend more than 50% of their budget outside of the Trico service area.
