A Collective Voice

The **Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits** is a unifying association formed to advance the common interests of more than 20,000 nonprofits in the Grand Canyon State. We are a statewide organization of, by, and for all of Arizona's nonprofits.


The Alliance protects the interests of the nonprofit sector by being a representative at the Arizona Legislature and state regulatory agencies. We promote the nonprofit sector by projecting a **collective voice** to the public about the sector's essential contributions, needs and significant challenges in our communities. **Our issues focus for 2010:**

- **Responding to the Economic Crisis:** The economy is front and center in the minds of every citizen and nonprofit in Arizona. The Alliance has partnered with the **National Council of Nonprofits** and agencies throughout Arizona to help organizations understand the implications for nonprofits in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).
- **Promoting Community Partnerships to Meet Vital Needs:** As Arizona communities struggle with the ability to meet common needs while the economy is reeling, the Alliance supports efforts to form partnerships between government, business, community institutions and nonprofits.
- **Reducing Health Care Costs for Nonprofit Employers:** The Alliance supports health care reform that 1) increases flexibility for small employers to pool resources for cost reduction, and 2) addresses the unique circumstances of nonprofit employers.

Working in concert with the **National Council of Nonprofits**, of which the Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits is a member, the Alliance supports efforts to assure that the needs of Arizona's nonprofits are included in **federal initiatives**. In addition, included in the membership dues, Alliance Nonprofit members are also a members of the **National Council of Nonprofits** which provides technical assistance to state association members through web and audio conferencing and publications.
